## Test Format

Thai Language Proficiency Test is hosted by Technology Promotion Association (Thailand-Japan). The test objective is to evaluate foreigners' abilities in Thai language. The test will not result in "pass" or "fail", but will indicate the test taker's level (beginner, elementary, intermediate, advanced, or proficient).

*\*The test paper should be written completely in Thai letters.*

Level	Definitions
<b>T1</b>	<b>Beginner</b> Able to read and write Thai, and able to understand basic vocabulary and grammar. Also can create short sentences about their daily life situations.
<b>T2</b>	<b>Elementary</b> Able to read and write Thai fluently, and understand daily life vocabulary and grammar well. Also have good listening comprehension and are able to communicate in daily life situations.
<b>T3</b>	<b>Intermediate</b> Able to understand complicated sentences, and are able to communicate properly. Can understand Thai articles in general topics in newspapers or magazines, and also are able to use Thai language at the workplace.
<b>T4</b>	<b>Advanced</b> Able to understand more complicated sentences than intermediate level sentences. They can read, listen, and understand content about economics, politics, and social issues in newspapers, magazines, T.V., or radio channels. They can also use Thai language confidently at the workplace and are able to live in Thailand without language problems.
<b>T5</b>	<b>Proficient</b> Able to use Thai language as proficiently as Thai people in all skill areas.
